

MILLIE ROTMAN SHIME ACADEMIC BRIDGING PROGRAM AWARDS

Academic Bridging Award for Contemporary Canada Course

Awarded to a student who has completed the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program and taken the Contemporary Canada course. Demonstrated academic ability and financial need are required. The value is approximately \$1500.

BMO Financial Group Access to Higher Education Award

These awards provide support to high achieving graduates of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program, with demonstrated financial need who are residents of Ontario. Preference is given to students who continue full-time. The value of the awards vary.

Brookfield Alan V. Dean Full-time Academic Bridging Graduation Award

Awarded to student(s) who complete the full-time Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program with a CGPA of at least 3.5 and continue to full time studies at Woodsworth College at the University of Toronto.

Evelyn Cotter Award

For an outstanding student from the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program. Recipients must have demonstrated financial need and be residents of Ontario. Preference is given to students who have postponed formal studies because of family responsibilities. The award value varies.

Evelyn Cotter Prize

Awarded to a graduate of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program who has written the best essay. Established by Woodsworth College to honour Evelyn Cotter, who was the Director of the College's Effective Study Program and an instructor in the Pre-University Program. The prize is a \$100 book voucher.

Carol Fitzpatrick Scholarship

This scholarship was established by friends of Carol McKay, who for many years was the Director of the Pre-University Program. This scholarship is awarded to an outstanding graduate of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program who continues degree studies at Woodsworth College. The value varies.

The McCrossan Awards

This scholarship provides recognition to an outstanding student entering first-year studies either through the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program or via direct-entry from high school. Recipients must have demonstrated financial need and be Ontario residents. The value of the award varies.

Tom Mitchinson and David Connolly Award

This scholarship is awarded to an outstanding first-year Woodsworth College student who is of Aboriginal background and is studying full-time in the social sciences or humanities. Recipients must have demonstrated financial need and be Ontario residents, and not be receiving band funding. This award is renewable for 4 years contingent on the student being enrolled in full-time and maintaining good academic standing.

Eleanor Morgan Prize

Woodsworth College established the Eleanor Morgan Prize in 1993. The prize is named after the former Senior Tutor of Woodsworth College and Coordinator of the Literature program. This prize, which is a \$100 book voucher, is awarded to an outstanding graduate of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program Literature course.

David Nimmo Academic Bridging Graduate Award

This scholarship was established in honour of Dr. David Nimmo, former Director of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program. The Award is given to an outstanding graduate who continues either full or part-time at Woodsworth College, has demonstrated financial need and is a resident of Ontario. The value of the award varies.

Sam and Mary Restivo Family Admission Scholarship

Awarded to a student entering Woodsworth College on a full-time basis, after being away from formal education for a considerable length of time. Recipients must have demonstrated financial need and be Ontario residents. The value of this award varies

Philip Stanbury Award

Awarded to a promising student who has completed the Literature course in the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program and who continues either full or part-time at Woodsworth College. The value of the award varies.

Ian Stewart Prize

Woodsworth College established this prize in 1995. It is named after the former Pre-University History course Co-ordinator. This prize is awarded to an outstanding graduate of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program History course who proceeds to degree studies at Woodsworth College. The prize is a \$100 book voucher.

John and Florence Warren Scholarship

Awarded to a graduate of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program, who is entering undergraduate degree studies at Woodsworth College. Recipients must have demonstrated financial need and be Ontario residents. The value varies.

William Waters Academic Bridging Awards

For outstanding graduates of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program with demonstrated financial need who are residents of Ontario and who enrol in an undergraduate program at Woodsworth College. Award amounts vary from \$1250 to \$2500.

Woodsworth College Book Box Award

The Book Box Scholarship is awarded to outstanding graduates of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program who enrol in degree studies either full or part-time at Woodsworth College. The value of the awards vary.

Wronowski-Rose Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded based on academic merit to outstanding graduates of the Millie Rotman Shime Academic Bridging Program. Preference is given to those who have completed the Introduction to Literature course and are continuing studies at Woodsworth College in the Humanities.
