Woodsworth College Council Information Sheet

Woodsworth College Council functions in an advisory capacity to the College and meets four times per academic year. Council hears reports from College departments, such as the Registrar's Office, the Program Office, the Residence, and the Professional and International Programs Office. The Principal also reports on important issues for the College and the University.

The Council recommends for approval to the Faculty of Arts and Science proposals for new academic programs; proposals for major and minor modifications to existing academic programs; and proposals for the modification of existing diploma and certificate programs, pursuant to the University's Policy on Diploma and Certificate Programs.

Additionally, important topics regarding the College, the Faculty of Arts & Science, and the University at large will be discussed. Documents will be sent to Council members in advance of each meeting. These should be read so as to be prepared for discussions.

- 16 ex-officio Members (Principal, The Vice-Principal, the Registrar, the Dean of Students, the presidents of WCSA, AAWC and Residence Council, a Don of the residence, and others.)
- 13 members of the teaching staff (College and affiliated programs)
- 3 other appointees (The Principal appoints these from across the University)
- 6 Members of the administrative staff of the College
- 4 alumni of Woodsworth College
- 1 don of the Woodsworth College Residence
- 20 Woodsworth College students
