This award was established through the generosity of Alayne and Kenneth Christie in recognition of Alayne's experience as an undergraduate student. She took her degree at Woodsworth College as a part-time, mature student. The Christies' goal is to support students engaged in similar academic pursuits. Two awards are available.

Conditions of the award:

1. To be awarded during the Fall/ Winter session, the Alayne and Kenneth Christie Award will assist part-time, mature students who are working a significant number of hours per week (i.e. more than 20 hours) while intending to complete their undergraduate degree.
2. The award will cover 2/3 of the tuition cost for one Y course (or the equivalent).
3. To be eligible, students must be studying part-time, be a Canadian resident and be working while enrolled. (Given the current pandemic, we will consider employment prior to March 2020). Students must have completed one Y course through the Faculty of Arts & Science with a minimum grade of C before being considered for this award.
4. Students receiving financial support from their employers are not eligible for this award.
