- 1. Summer grant applications are available from May 4 to July 27, 2020.
- 2. Grants are a secondary source of financial aid provided on the basis of financial need for education-related expenses. The average summer session grant is \$500 \$750.
- 3. Students are normally required to have applied for other types of financial assistance such as OSAP and other government student aid prior to seeking grant funding.
- 4. Visiting students and International students are usually not eligible for this grant; however, should you encounter unexpected financial difficulties you should complete and submit the application.
- 5. You may be asked to provide receipts and documentation for some expenses.
- 6. After completing the application please save it as a new file including your student number and email it to wdwregistrar@utoronto.ca.
- 7. It normally takes 7 to 10 business days for an application to be reviewed by the Grant Committee and a decision to be made.
