Credit course for supervised participation in a faculty research project. Offered only when a fulltime appointed faculty member from the Centre for Criminology & Sociolegal Studies is willing and available to supervise.

Students must contact Faculty members currently teaching in the Criminology and Sociolegal Studies program to find out if there are any research participation opportunities available. Students requesting enrolment in a research participation course are advised to select an alternative course until the status of their enrolment is confirmed.

Enrolment is limited to students in the Criminology and Sociolegal Studies program (Arts and Science, STG Campus). Students are not entitled to take more than 1.0 full research participation course. Approved proposals will be added on the student's academic record on ACORN by the Program Office.

Prerequisites:

- 1. 9 FCEs. A CGPA of at least 3.0 is recommended.
- 2. Approval of the Undergraduate Coordinator is required.

Research Ethics Approval:

Any research conducted on human subjects at U of T requires Research Ethics approval; and research conducted on students requires the additional approval of the office of the Vice-Provost, Students. This is non negotiable. Students wishing to conduct a 396 course that includes research on human subjects must initiate the process at least 8 weeks before the start of classes.
