ELIGIBILITY:

Students must take a minimum of 2.0 FCE in the Fall-Winter Term (September 2024 to April 2025). Students are permitted to accept only one work study position per program period. Students do not have to be OSAP eligible to apply for work study positions.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Working closely with the Coordination, Student Programs & Access, the International Experience Assistant will work to develop a sense of belonging for international students at Woodsworth College. They will be responsible for organizing a number of events and programs throughout the year that celebrate the many cultures our student population comes from. In addition they will create programs to support international students in their transition to living in, and experiencing the best of, Canada. They will also assist with the operation of a weekly drop-in program, where they will interact with students and help them develop a sense of community.

- Collaboratively develop and facilitate programming for international & domestic students.
- Develop and facilitate a weekly drop-in program.
- Provide weekly updates to Coordinator, Student Programs & Access through team meetings
- Attend one-on-one meetings as required
- Communicate with supervisor in a timely manner
- Additional duties as assigned
